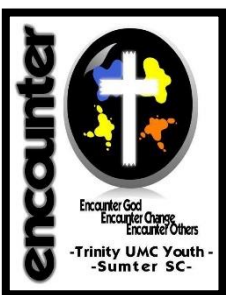
Children – KiCK: (Sunday afternoons)

Salkehatchie Summer Service is a servant ministry located in selected areas throughout South Carolina involving high school and college age youth, adult community leaders and persons of different cultures as they come together to upgrade housing to make each home safer, warmer, and drier. This summer several youth and adults from Trinity UMC will either travel to the Loris Salkehatchie Camp (Horry County) or remain in the Sumter community to participate in a Salkehatchie camp. We would LOVE for you to join the fun!

Here's how you can join this mission:

#1. Pray!

- for the leaders of all Salkehatchie camps (especially the Sumter and Loris Camps);
- for the home selection process – that God would open our eyes to see those in need of our help. Pray for those selecting the homes to have wisdom, compassion, and a vision for what can be instead of what currently is;
- for the families who will open their homes to the Salkehatchie team members;
- for the adult volunteers and youth campers who will pay \$250 each as well as give a week of their summer, to serve God through the Salkehatchie mission;
- for yourself! Salkehatchie is *not* a spectator sport – ask God to show you how your gifts can be used for this mission. If you are apprehensive, ask God to give you the courage to step out of your comfort zone. If there are obstacles holding you back, ask God to clear the way.

#2. Save the Date!

- The Loris Salkehatchie Camp will take place in Horry County **June 15 – 22, 2019**.
- The Sumter Salkehatchie Camp will take place in Sumter County **June 22 – 29, 2019**.

#3. Loose Bills for Lent!

- There is a Bulletin Board located outside of Angela's office that started out with 150 envelopes labeled with amounts ranging from \$1-\$150 (2 envelopes for each amount).
- Many of you have already started to pull envelopes off of the board as you fill them with donations – THANK YOU!!!! #4. Get Involved and Be Part of the Team!

Here is a list of the opportunities for service where volunteers are needed:

- If you wish to volunteer with the Loris Salkehatchie camp, please register online at www.salkehatchie.org and contact Mitch or Nicole Grunsky to share with them your interest in the camp.
- If you wish to volunteer with the Sumter Salkehatchie camp, please contact Angela in the Discipleship Ministries office at the church (803-773-9393) and she will be happy to help you get plugged in to one of the areas below:
 - o The Breakfast Crew: Breakfast is served at Bethel UMC, Oswego each morning (Sunday 6/23) – Saturday (6/29). The Breakfast Crew helps with the preparation, serving, and clean-up of the breakfast meals.
 - o Snack Crew: Snacks are delivered to each work site mid-morning (around 10:00am) and mid-afternoon (around 3:00pm) Monday-Friday. If you would like to purchase and/or deliver snacks to one of the worksites we ask that you commit to delivering snacks to the same site each day at the same time (either morning or afternoon).
 - o Runners: Each home/work site is assigned a “runner”. These volunteers go to Lowes and other local hardware/building supply businesses to purchase needed building materials, hardware, etc. needed by the work sites. The money for the items needed is provided through the camp. Having a truck is a plus but not necessary! You will need to register for camp in order to serve in this capacity so please make sure to contact Angela.
 - o Work-Site Adult: These are the adults that will work at one of the home sites throughout the week. You must be registered for camp in order to work fulfill this need so please don't wait to sign up! Do it today! www.salkehatchie.org
